Gentlemen:

This letter is written pursuant to a request from Steve Merritt of C.S.S. Technology, Inc. Since TALEM, Inc. has been involved in several environmental studies related to the use of Roadbond EN 1™, Mr. Merritt felt that we were qualified to review and comment on a study conducted by GemChem, Inc. entitled "Environmental Performance Test Report" (See Reference 1 above). In accordance with this request, we have reviewed the report and our opinion is provided herein.

The purpose of the GemChem, Inc. study was to determine if Roadbond EN 1™ soil stabilizer is safe to use, and is an environmentally friendly road bonding application on dirt and gravel roadways in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The GemChem study was conducted in accordance with standard acute & chronic toxicity testing guidelines and procedures EPA-717-C-118, EPA-821-R-02-013, EPA-823-B-98-004, OECD 215, and OPPTS 850.1075. Based on these procedures, soil samples treated with Roadbond EN 1™ in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations were subjected to 28-day chronic tests utilizing rainbow trout. The results of these tests showed that there was no significant difference in the mortality and growth of the fish exposed to Roadbond EN 1™ compared to those not exposed.

After reviewing the GemChem, Inc. letter report and supporting data, we agree with their conclusion that Roadbond EN 1™ is environmentally safe to fish when applied in accordance with the manufacturer's recommended application rates. Furthermore, TALEM, Inc. has conducted analytical studies on Roadbond EN 1™ treated soils samples that also support that the product is environmentally safe (Reference 2 above).
